**NON-REGULAR (Additional) CLASSES** Involving Multiple Dog Entries:

**STUD DOG CLASS** will be for Stud Dogs and **TWO** of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be in the ring with their Get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its Breed Competition, or some other non-regular class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS** will be for the Brood Bitches and **TWO** of their Produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not necessarily be owner of Produce. While the merits of the brood bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other non-regular class.

As the judges decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

**BRACE CLASS (Two Identical Ownership).** Brace will require a fee of \$11.00 as a **UNIT**. The dogs comprising the Brace **MUST** be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be a part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for **“BRACE CLASS ONLY”**, Fee \$25.00 per dog, plus \$11.00 for the Unit will apply. In marking entries for **“BRACE CLASS ONLY”** full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes – **“BRACE CLASS”**. If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising **EACH** Brace must be designated “Brace No. 1, Brace No. 2, etc.”

**VETERAN DOG/VETERAN BITCH:** Any dog or bitch will be eligible for this Class who is 7 years of age on or before the date of this Show.

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**AWARD OF MERIT**

At the discretion of the Judge, an Award of Merit may be given to the following number of dogs: The number of awards to be given will be equal to 10% of the number of specials entered at the time of closing starting with 15. This number is to be rounded downward (see chart below). The number entered will disregard all absentees and transfer from the classes.
